Please arrive promptly at the time indicated for the session you plan to attend. Each session will begin with a pre-registration information presentation which all new students and parents are expected attend prior to enrolling.

No appointments are necessary for the registration sessions

To ensure that your registration goes smoothly, it is critical that you provide all of the required documents at the time of enrollment. <u>Please refer to the reverse side for a complete list of required documents</u>.

After August 4th, the next opportunity for students to enroll will be Wednesday, August 10th, which is after school has started. Enrollments on any of the dates listed above will not require an appointment.

CENTENNIAL HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELING OFFICE

The following documents MUST be provided to enroll a student:

- TWO verifications of residency
 - A house contract/lease, utility bill, pay stub, etc. (must be current within 30 days)

The following documents must be provided in order to place a student into classes:

- Copy of student's final transcript
 - Students recommended for Honors or AP classes must provide a letter indicating such from the previous school
- Students with special needs must provide a current Individual Education Plan (IEP).
- Proof of student's age (i.e. birth certificate)
- Currently updated Immunization Certificate (Form #3231 only)
- Ear, Eye, Dental Certificate (Form #3300)
 - Georgia State Law requires these to be on a State of Georgia form, available from student's doctor or at the North Fulton Regional Health Center located at 3155 Royal Drive, Alpharetta, GA (404-332-1958)
- Picture ID of adult enrolling student
 - Adult enrolling the student must be at least 18 years of age
- Complete mailing address of previous school
- Attendance records from previous school
- Discipline records from previous school
- Copy of student's social security card (if available)

STUDENT ENROLLMENT MAY BE DELAYED IF ALL OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ARE NOT PROVIDED

The student (regardless of age) MUST come with an adult to register for classes.

It is the responsibility of the enrolling adult to obtain all necessary documents from the previous school.
