#### **Personal Fitness**

- Exempt Personal Fitness by meeting 1 of 3 possible criteria
  - Athletics/Fencing
  - Marching Band
  - JROTC
- Intent to Waive Contract: Informs CHS not to schedule student for P.F. in grades 9-11
- Waiver Forms: Verify student has successfully met waiver criteria
- Deadline to meet criteria and turn in waiver form: 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of May their Junior year

#### Internships

- Opportunity for all students to do an Internship in a career area of their interest
- Student receives a grade and credit for course
- Students are primarily responsible for securing an internship site and transportation


