



Mathematics (4 Credits)





• Honors Level: Same pace and content as on-level courses; but students are 1 year ahead in math (starts in 8th Grade).

• <u>Accelerated</u>: Very rigorous/fast paced; students complete 3 years of math courses in 2 years.




What is a pathway? Why become a pathway completer?


A pathway is a sequence of 3 specific courses focusing on an area of study.

Pathway Offerings at Centennial




