College Credit Now

What is Dual Enrollment?

- Opportunity for qualified high school students to earn college credit while in high school.
- Student is simultaneously enrolled in HS and college
- Funded by the State

Dual Enrollment vs AP classes... What's the difference?



AP Courses

- Meets everyday
- College credit tied to AP exam score
- Recommended for students applying to competitive colleges

Dual Enrollment Courses

- Meets 2 days a week
- Student must apply & be accepted by the college
- College credit awarded by the college offering the course

College Math at Centennial

- 2 semester (year-long) commitment
- Will meet either Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs from 8:00 –
 9:15 with instructor from GTC
- 3 college credits <u>and</u> 1.0 high school credit earned per term for successful completion
- College credit is potentially transferable to other institutions
- Must maintain a "C" or better average

A = 95 + 7 = 102 D = 70 + 7 = 77 B = 85 + 7 = 92 F = 60C = 75 + 7 = 82

Grade Conversion

Expectations for Dual Enrollment Students

- On-time attendance for all class meetings and will communicate any problems directly to the instructor
 - Will be automatically dropped from course if absent 20% of classes
- Students will follow GTC processes and procedures and respond to college officials in a timely manner
- Students will complete all assignments and adhere to all deadlines set forth by the GTC instructor
- Parents are not contacted by the GTC instructor—similar to any college course (FERPA release)

GTC College Algebra Dual Enrollment Admission Requirements

- CHS Rising Junior or Senior who has successfully completed one of the following pre-requisite courses:
 - CCGPS Adv Algebra
 - CCGPS Adv Algebra Honors
 - GPS Pre-Calculus Honors
 - Accelerated Pre-Calculus Honors
- Residency: Must reside in GA at least 12 months

SAT (minimum score)

- Critical Reading 480
- Math 440

ACT (minimum score)

- Reading 17
- English 20
- Math 19

COMPASS

(minimum score)

- Reading 79
- Writing 62
- PreAlgebra 37
- Algebra 37

- Pay \$25 application fee
- Online Accel application via GACollege411 website

DEADLINE #2: **May 1, 2015**

Submit the following documents to GTC:

- Request Official HS Transcript
 - Submit form directly to Ms. White in the Counseling Office
- College Credit Now Consent Form
 - Submit form to Counseling Office
- Submit copy of proof of GA residency
- Submit official SAT, ACT, or COMPASS scores
 - Must be requested directly from test agency
 - **▼** Last SAT to meet deadline is March
 - Last ACT to meet deadline is February
 - **▼** COMPASS will be offered on-site in April
