QUESTION	ANSWER
What are the differences between the GRADUATION FEES and the SENIOR DUES?	GRADUATION FEES pay for the ceremony venue and graduation-related attire: cap, tassel, gown, and diploma cover. This fee is required for students who wish to participate in the graduation ceremony. The fee amount has not yet been determined. SENIOR DUES (\$45) pay for senior-specific social activities that occur throughout Senior Week.

Should students create a Common Application and a Coalition Application account?	Students should utilize the application portal preferred by the college, as colleges may not offer an application opportunity through both portals. If colleges state no preference and the application is available on both portals, students should select the portal through which they plan to submit most other college applications.
How should students send their ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) test scores to colleges?	Students should request an AP test score release to the college(s) of choice through Collegeboard.org.
