Prospective Student Meeting

- The Prospective Student Meeting will be on **Tuesday, April 30, at 7pm**. If you have not already heard from your county coordinator, she will likely be in touch shortly to help determine which schools will be hosting the prospective student meeting. Like in previous years, this meeting will be a video conference and will use the same technology that the class, itself, uses.
- We're beginning to post a list of schools that have confirmed they will be hosting the meeting on our website. If your school will be hosting, please just shoot me an e-mail and I'll get you added to the list!

Changes to 2013-14 Application Process

- The online application will be available from May 15 – June 15. This is because students will be required to upload a copy of their transcript/report card that includes high school grades through Spring semester directly to the online application.
- We recommend students request a transcript from their high school with Fall 2012 grades before the end of the school year and upload this document along with their Spring 2013 report card to the online application. We will discuss this further during the Prospective Student Meeting. High schools are no longer required to send transcripts to Georgia Tech for applicants to the Distance Calculus Program.
