

Students asked questions about the college application process.



## **GA Apply to College Event Outcome Data:**









166 CHS Seniors participated in the event on November 17<sup>th</sup>

52.6% of surveyed students reported he event influenced their decision to apply to college

83.3% of surveyed students reported the event encouraged them to apply earlier than they would have otherwise

95% of surveyed students recommended that Centennial continue to offer this event in the future

## College Week Outcome Results:



As of November 22nd, over 300 of CHS Seniors had completed college applications.



This is a 33% increase as compared to # of students who had applied by the end of 1st semester each of the past 2 school years
