



## Steps for the application process to GPC Dual Enrollment:

### Centennial High School Deadlines:

**March 31<sup>st</sup> - Students must apply directly to GPC. They must also submit required Centennial paperwork to the Centennial Counseling Office.**

**May 1<sup>st</sup> – All other required documents must be received by GPC.**

1. Meet with your high school counselor regarding your plans.
2. Review eligibility below:
  - a. Must be a high school junior or senior
  - b. Must have a 3.0 core GPA as calculated by GPC
  - c. Must have either eligible SAT or ACT scores
    - i. SAT total score of 970 or higher with minimums of 440 math and 480 critical reading (total = combined math and critical reading, writing excluded)
    - ii. ACT composite of 20 with minimums of 18 math and 20 English
    - iii. Use code 5711 to send SAT (& AP exam) scores to GPC and code 0806 to send ACT scores (location for scores go to GPC Clarkston Campus)
3. Apply to GPC following these steps:
  - a. Goto [www.gacollege411.org](http://www.gacollege411.org)
  - b. Click on the tab titled "College Planning"
  - c. Scroll down to "Applications" and click
  - d. Go to "Apply to College and Track Your Applications: and click
  - e. From this point choose GPC. If you experience trouble with the application process please call 678.891.3535 (GPC Contact Center) for assistance
  - f. Submit the \$20.00 application fee payment online
4. Deadlines for application:
  - a. Fall Semester– July 1
  - b. Spring Semester– November 1
  - c. Summer Semester– April (ACCEL & MOWR do not pay summer costs)
  - d. Please note that some high schools impose different application deadlines **(Please note Centennial Deadline listed above)**
5. Submit required documents (parental consent, official HS transcript, immunization, and verification of lawful presence). For assistance with these documents please call either the Dunwoody DE Office at 770.274.5375 or the Newton DE Office at 770.278.1270.
6. If admitted you will receive an acceptance letter from GPC Admissions. You may monitor your admission status at: <https://eapps.gpc.edu/mystatus>
7. Your DE advisor's office will send you a welcome email with a link to part one of the online orientation. Please complete Part One, pay the \$15.00 orientation fee, and contact the DE offices listed in #5 for advisement appointments.
8. Your DE advisor will offer academic guidance, including math placement, and review all funding options relevant to your situation (public school, private school, home school).
