Fulton County Schools, in partnership with the Gwinnett Tech Alpharetta Campus, provides students an opportunity to participate in a cohort program to earn high demand career tech certificates along with core academic college credits while in high school.

MOWR can:

Who can participate in the MOWR North Fulton/Gwinnett Tech initiative?

Students in grades 11 and 12 that attend Northeast and Northwest Learning Community High Schools, and Riverwood and North Springs High Schools.

Students accepted into the College and Career Cohort will be provided transportation to and from their high school campus and Gwinnett Technical College, Alpharetta Campus. Courses are free to students who qualify for admission.

Gwinnett Tech Alpharetta Campus Admission Requirements:

SAT: 480 Reading, 440 Math

ACT: 17 Reading, 19 Math

Accuplacer: 64 Reading, 70 Writing, 57 Math

*No GPA requirement for participation.
