Applying to Move On When Ready (MOWR) for 2017-18

*** READ CAREFULLY ***

- Applying for the MOWR program requires students to complete **two** separate application processes:
 - 1) The **high school** application process
- 2) The college application process
- Students must complete the <u>all of the required steps for both</u> the **high school** and **college** for their application to be considered for admission into the MOWR program.
- Students <u>must meet all</u> of the high school and college <u>MOWR application deadlines</u> as listed below to be accepted. Deadlines are in accordance with Fulton County Schools guidelines and policies.
- Students <u>must meet all</u> of the high school and college <u>MOWR admission requirements</u> to be accepted.

After submitting all portions of the MOWR Application:

- Check your admission status by logging on to the college's website with the Login ID.
- The college will notify students directly if they have been accepted or denied.
- During spring course registration, students will be registered for a full 6 period schedule of high school classes for next year until the college has provided Centennial with verification a of student acceptance.
- After students are accepted, student schedules will be adjusted. At that time additional documents and steps on GAFutures.com will be required for students to complete for state funding to cover MOWR course tuition.
