

What is the difference between the P2L Diversion and Mentorship Programs?

Both programs begin with our foundation of forming a partnership with schools, families, and students, which supports our belief that **there is another way**.



Diversion Program

Who is this for?

First-time and repeat "offenders" for vaping, substance use, or behavioral infractions.

What does it look like?

The Pathways2Life Diversion Program focuses on a **restorative shift** in the student's thoughts and behaviors as opposed to punitive discipline (suspension, expulsion, etc).

3 Diversion Sessions are completed **in exchange** for a reduction of discipline determined at the school's discretion.

We follow a **proven process** for assessing risk factors and protective factors to help **support better outcomes** for the student in the future.

All participants complete the **CRAFFT + Nicotine** screening tool to assess Alcohol, Nicotine, and Other Substance Use risk and dependence levels.

After the required 3 sessions, a **Letter of Completion** will be sent to the referring counselor/admin. Voluntary extended support sessions will be offered to the student.

How to refer?

Fill out the Pathways2Life referral form and indicate that it is a diversion program referral.

Mentorship Program

Who is this for?

Any student in need of support, encouragement, and guidance.

What does it look like?

The Pathways2Life Mentorship Program is a voluntary support for students in need of a **safe space** for encouragement, guidance, and a path towards a more hopeful future.

Mentorship Sessions are completed in **4-6** session blocks.

All Pathways2Life mentors are trained to assist students in identifying **strengths**, **values, passions, and goals for the future.**

Participants are **not required** to complete the CRAFFT + Nicotine Screening tool, although we will offer it if we feel it would be beneficial.

Pathways2Life **will not** provide a Letter of Completion, however, we will collaborate with school counseling/admin to best support mentorship students.

How to refer?
