RULES

Must attend a Fulton County or Atlanta Public School to participate. Participating schools are required to create and submit an innovative in-school prom safety campaign, utilizing any form of multi-media (.i.e. Social Media, Videography, Photography, Print, Art, etc.). Each "Prom Safety Campaign" must incorporate one of the following themes or messages:

- Prevention of driving under drug and alcohol influence
- Prevention of alcohol consumption
- Prevention of drug usage
- + Prevention of texting while driving
- Prevention of peer pressure and bullying
- → Prevention of violence/weapons
